_____ Art Expressionists

Open to Elementary Students. This class will explore expressionist artists and art work to create art inspired by this theme. Weekly assignments will be centered around the visual representation of mood and emotion, and students will be encouraged to create bold, expressive art pieces! Students will explore color, texture, pattern and the mixing of mediums and materials in their art making. Instructors will draw on Social Thinking concepts and utilize works from various artists throughout history to guide students through the exploration of colors.

Victory Strummers

Open to Middle and High School Students. Students in Victory Strummers will learn to play open-tuned guitars, which are used frequently in blues and rock music, and are an appropriate guitar for beginning students. All guitars will be provided and can even be taken home to practice! In addition to playing open-tuned guitars, students will learn about and get to play a new string instrument each week. Playing open-tuned guitars can improve fine/gross motor skills, enhance attention, and is a great form of self-expression. Plus, it's really fun to just ROCK OUT!

Outdoor Club

Open to Middle and High School Students. The goals of Outdoor Club are to create opportunities for students to discover, participate, and enjoy various outdoor adventures. This fall, Outdoor Club will focus on paddle boarding, kayaking, and bouldering skills and techniques. Utilizing partnerships with local climbing gyms, guiding companies, and relying on the expertise of Victory's qualified staff, students will receive excellent instruction and support.

Victory Drummers

Open to Middle and High School Students. In this class, students will learn different styles and patterns of drumming, along with reading simple time signatures, such as 4/4 and 3/4 time. Students will be encouraged and supported to work together in a group by sharing and turn-taking, along with expressing themselves on the drums in their own unique way.

____ Basketball

Open to Middle and High School Students. This class is a unique partnership between The Other Side of Basketball (TOSOB) and Victory Academy, aimed at providing students an opportunity to improve their individual basketball skills in a fun-filled environment. TOSOB's highly experienced coaches, along with support from TOSOB kids and Victory staff, will help teach students the importance of team structure within a competitive environment. Skills emphasized (but not limited to): overall understanding of the game, ball handling, passing, shooting, and team work. TOSOB staff will be on-site for the first six class sessions working directly with class participants and Victory staff to gain self-confidence and a better understanding of themselves through basketball. The remaining sessions will be taught by Victory staff.

Illustration and Animation

Open to Middle and High School Students. Students will begin with exploration in various methods of illustrating using both traditional techniques and technology. Additional focus will be placed on exercising executive functioning skills in pursuit of solving visual problems.
